COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

- NCA will be following relevant federal, state, and local laws and guidelines in hosting the Annual Convention and will adjust plans based on changes in these laws and guidelines.
- Per the current King County Health Order, all convention attendees must bring proof of vaccination or a recent negative COVID-19 test for entry to hotels, the convention center, and local restaurants.
- Per the health order, we ask that members who are unvaccinated stay home, stay safe, and do not travel to attend our convention.
- Anyone experiencing symptoms of illness on-site should quarantine in their room until obtaining a negative COVID-19 test.
- Wearing a mask will be required at the NCA Annual Convention in accordance with the Washington state renewed mask mandate that requires that everyone wear masks indoors, even people who are fully vaccinated.
- To help ensure attendee safety, NCA will:
 - Place hand sanitizing stations throughout convention meeting space.
 - Keep a stock of masks in the registration area.
 - Provide packages of sanitizing wipes in all meeting rooms to allow participants to wipe down high-touch surfaces.
