### 10 Tips on How to Promote Communication Teaching, Research and Service:

- 1. Host a workshop for faculty across campus on communication skills
- 2. Host a R&R Clinic revise and resubmit– get advice and improve
- 3. Host a colloquium for research projects across campus
- 4. Assess service workload to distribute work among faculty and prioritize
- Events: Communication day/week, speech contest, and/or bring in external speakers
- 6. Facilitate multi-faceted media presence (student newspaper, social media, press releases)
- 7. Engage faculty in community
- 8. Distribute/Develop a "Brag Sheet" to go out on a weekly basis
- 9. Create an advisory board (parents, faculty, administrators)
- 10. Use alumni mentoring to connect with Undergraduates
