

2010-11 COLLEGE MAJORS UNEMPLOYMENT AND EARNINGS:

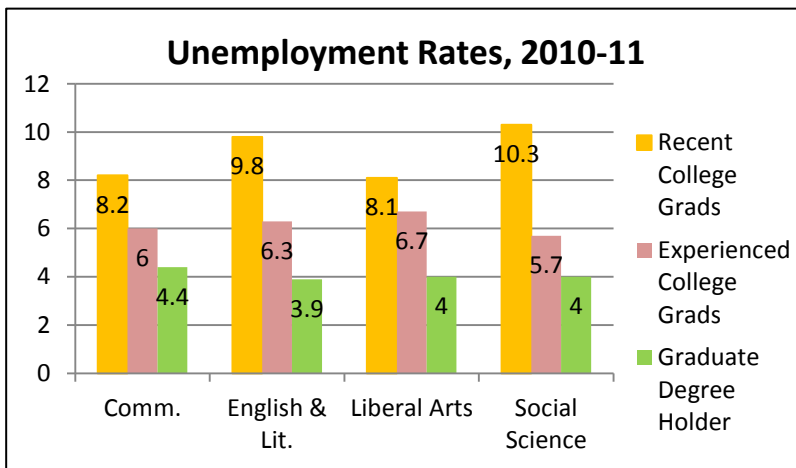


Figure 1: Unemployment rates 2010-11. *Source: Georgetown Public Policy Institute (cew.georgetown.edu)*

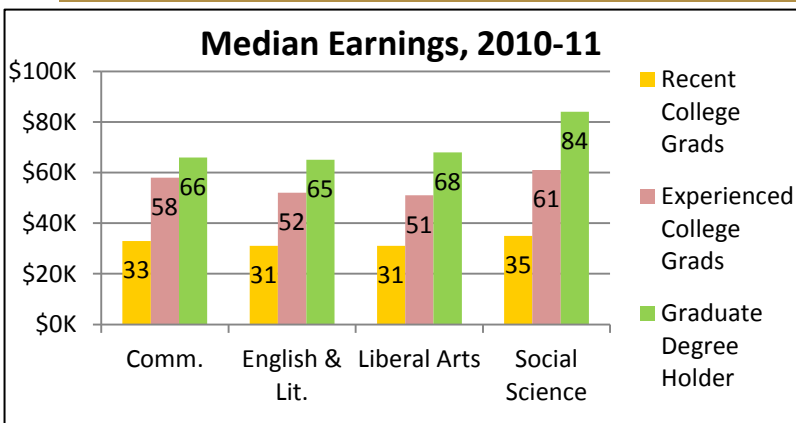


Figure 2: Median income earnings, 2010-11 *Source: Georgetown Public Policy Institute (cew.georgetown.edu)*

This C-Brief provides data about unemployment and earnings rates relevant to our discipline. The data comes from the report *Hard Times: College Majors, Employment, and Earnings*, released by the Georgetown Public Policy Institute. Figure 1 illustrates the unemployment rate by percentage for those with degrees in Communication(s), English & Literature, Liberal Arts, and Social Sciences. Figure 2 displays the median earnings in thousands of dollars.
