




CONFERRED DEGREES IN COMMUNICATION, 1970-2014

The National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) is the primary federal entity for collecting and analyzing data related to education in the United States and is housed within the U.S. Department of Education and the Institute of Education Sciences. NCES has reported on total postsecondary degrees conferred, by discipline, since 1970—including for Communication, Journalism, and Related Programs.


Number of Conferred Bachelor's Degrees in Communication, Journalism, and Related Programs, 1970–2014
