

MOST POPULAR ACADEMIC MAJORS FOR POWER 5 CONFERENCE FOOTBALL PLAYERS, 2015–2016

Bleacher Report recently reported on the most popular majors for Power 5 Conference Football Players. Those conferences include the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), Big Ten Conference (B1G), Big 12 Conference (Big 12), Pac-12 Conference (Pac-12), and Southeastern Conference (SEC).

Communication was the most popular major reported for Power 5 Players, with 323 majors, followed by Sociology (294), Business (291), General Studies (289), and Arts & Sciences (195). Of the 65 universities in the Power 5 conference, 38 reported Communication as being among their top five majors.

The University of Southern California reported the highest number of football players majoring in Communication (23).
