

RANKINGS FOR FEDERAL SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE R&D

In February of 2022, the Consortium of Social Science Associations released its *College & University Rankings by Federal Social and Behavioral Science R&D Funding (FY 2020)*. These rankings highlight the leading institutions for federally financed research and development expenditures in the social and behavioral sciences. Data are derived from the National Center for Science and Education Statistics' *Higher Education Research and Development (HERD) Survey* for fiscal year 2020.

The leading institutions for federally financed R&D expenditures are listed below.
